



**Sub: Reimbursement of Ayurvedic/Homeopathic medicine
to retired employees under CHSS-reg.**

Chief Administrative Officer, NFC, Hyderabad may please refer his ID note No. NFC/CHSS/05/22/247 dated September 30, 2004 on the above subject.

The position as existing presently is that the medical attention and treatment under the Ayurvedic/Homeopathic treatment do not form part of the CHSS, but the facility is being availed of by the employees while in service under CS(MA) Rules. There is no provision in the CHSS about the coverage of the above two systems either while in service or thereafter. What is provided in the Scheme is that after retirement the employees can continue to avail of the facility which is obviously the Allopathic system. For this reason, unless the CS(MA) Rules are modified so as to extend the coverage to the retired employees, it would not be possible to bring the employees after retirement under the facility of Ayurvedic/Homeopathic System.
