

N.6: Fire safety at RRCAT

First-aid fire-fighting training is being regularly imparted to RRCAT employees, in order to prepare a fire squad of employees for immediate action on fire, with minimum loss of property and human life. This training program is conducted in two sessions: lectures followed by live demonstrations.

It is utmost essential to refresh, enhance, and update the technical knowledge of field staff like fire services. A full-fledged training program has been devised and is being regularly implemented, which includes lecture series, physical training and fire mock drills. In this lecture series, two lectures per month are conducted on various topics related to fire technology and emergency response plans. During lecture session, the information related to technical details of various fire-fighting gears, fire pumps, fire tenders, extension ladders, different types of hoses, breathing apparatus sets, fire extinguishers, small gears, salvage procedures etc. are provided. For practical knowledge update and operational control, the fire protocol during emergency conditions are discussed. This practical training also includes study on operational efficiency in fire-fighting and rescue operations. Fire drills with fire-fighting equipment along with fire mock drills were regularly conducted.

Regular physical training is also conducted at RRCAT fire station for maintaining fitness of the fire crew. This training includes running, sit-up, push-up, recruitment table cards (RTC) exercises.
